

AGGRAND Owned by AMSOIL Inc.

AGGRAND is a subdivision of a larger company called AMSOIL. AMSOIL produces environmentally friendly, **severe** extended drain capable synthetic lubricants (two-cycle oils, motor oils, diesel oils, transmission fluids, gear lubes, greases, hydraulic oils, etc). In many applications our synthetic motor oils and diesel oils are designed and guaranteed for 25,000 miles or one year (or an equivalent number of hours on heavy equipment). Oil analysis often indicates that the oil is good for even longer.

Under an account with the company you can order both product lines (the AGGRAND and AMSOIL products) at the discounted commercial account prices.

I mention this for a couple of reasons. One is that I've been using/selling the AMSOIL product line along with the AGGRAND product line for 10 years and have found BOTH the AMSOIL and the AGGRAND to be phenomenal product lines. The AGGRAND for the reasons outlined on our website and in this information packet, but AMSOIL is pretty spectacular in its own right.

I started using AMSOIL in my two cycles when I had a lawncare business. AMSOIL has offered a 100:1 two-cycle oil since even before I originally set up my account 10 years ago. It is GUARANTEED at 100:1 mix ratio for EVERY pre-mix two cycle engine.

Before I started using this product, I was using OEM grade petroleum two cycle oil at the recommended 32:1. I would literally foul a plug about 2-3 times per month and clog my exhaust screen just about as frequently. And, of course, anytime I was running my two-cycle engines, I looked like "pigpen" from Peanuts with this big cloud of blue smoke surrounding me everywhere I went.

After the switch to the AMSOIL 100:1 mix the blue smoke was GONE. Power was up. In the past 10 years since, some of which was still in commercial use, the rest in private residential use on my own property, I have not fouled ONE plug or ever clogged an exhaust screen. All of my 2-cycles still start right away every time I use them.

This is an awesome product (as are all the others) because it allows you to have ONE pre-mix 2-cycle can for all your 2-cycle equipment. You'll never have to worry about you or one of your family members or employees putting the 50:1 mix in the 32:1 application or vice versa.

And what about larger equipment such as tractors, diesel trucks, combines, balers, etc.? AMSOIL synthetic oils and filters generally outlast petroleum oils by **at least 3-5 times**, often even longer. AMSOIL has been offering extreme long

drain synthetic oils for over 30 years. They are PROVEN to offer better protection and fuel economy than other leading petroleum and synthetic lubes.

Equipment will last longer, the lubes will last longer for less frequent changes, fuel will last longer. Something to think about, especially since you can get the products at commercial pricing through your account.

The second reason I mention these products is because the paperwork I'm sending will all say AMSOIL on it, since that is the parent company. In addition, the Commercial Account "Profile Sheet" is going to ask you questions more specific to the AMSOIL line of products than to the AGGRAND. So, even though your account will likely be more focused on the AGGRAND product line, the profile sheet is focused more on the other side.

I'll often have farmers who, because of that issue, will fill out two of the questions on that entire page with "I'll be using fertilizer on my crops" and then leave the rest blank. AMSOIL doesn't like forms that are skimpy on information about the account. They'll send them back.

So, I recommend elaborating as much as possible on how you'll use the AGGRAND products in your business but also to include information about any AMSOIL products that you're even considering using. This will simply give you more ammunition to try and get the account setup to go through. I don't want you to lie. If you have no intention of using any AMSOIL products, please don't put them on the profile sheet. But, if you have interest, please indicate so on this form.

Please print as legibly as possible on these forms. I don't intend that to sound condescending, but I have had forms come back that were probably nearly illegible in their original form. But, once they are faxed to the company, they can get so bad that AMSOIL won't even be able to process them.

So, print as neatly as possible and find a fax machine that will give you the best transmission quality you can. It is much appreciated on this end.
